From the Superintendent's Desk....

As we begin 2026, Zeeland School District would like to thank our families, staff, and community members for their continued support and engagement. The start of a new year is traditionally a time for reflection and planning, and this year brings particularly important conversations about the future of our district. We value transparency and community involvement as we navigate decisions that will have a lasting impact on our students and the Zeeland community.

The Zeeland School Board will hold their board meeting on Monday, January 12, at 3:00 p.m. One of the items on the agenda will be to discuss the future of Zeeland School District for the 2026-2027 School Year. Current projections indicate that the district may have only 13 students enrolled in the coming school year, with no students in kindergarten through second grade. This reality presents a very difficult decision for the Board as it considers how best to fulfill its responsibility to provide a high-quality, sustainable educational program while also being fiscally responsible.

We encourage community members to attend this board meeting and participate in the discussion. This decision is not made lightly, and the Board welcomes public presence as it considers options and determines the best path forward for Zeeland School District. Your involvement and support are important as we work together during this challenging and pivotal time.

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Our school receives federal funds for Title I programs that are part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Under ESSA, you have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher(s).

As always, we want to keep our parents informed on the quality education we deliver. Sharing staff qualifications is an excellent way to illustrate our commitment to our students. The staff at any school defines the education environment, and we are devoted to finding the best quality teachers and paraprofessionals to work with your children to ensure our school is a place where they can succeed.

On the next page is a table that lists the teaching staff at our school along with their current position, degree major, any other graduate degree, certification or endorsement, years of teaching experience, and whether or not they meet the state qualifications and licensing requirements.

In addition, if at any time during the school year a teacher who is not highly qualified for four or more consecutive weeks teaches your child, you will receive timely notice from the school.
